Online Learning Survey

We are pleased to participate in the Online Learning Survey (OLS), provided by A. Willock Information Systems Inc. (AWIS) for the Ministry of Education and Child Care. The Online Learning Survey is a key data component of the Accountability and Quality Assurance Process for Online Learning Schools and is an important source of province-wide information about student's Online Learning experiences. Your participation is an important contribution to understanding and improving the Online Learning educational experiences of students across the province. Please find information about the survey below.

- All information collected is protected under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.
- There are no student-specific login codes, so responses cannot be tied to students.
- All responses will be kept anonymous: no one will be able to personally identify any students or parents through their responses.
- If any personal or identifying information is included in the responses, it will be deleted before results are processed and stored.
- Data will be stored in Canada and accessible only within Canada.
- This survey is voluntary, and participation is encouraged but not required.
- This survey is targeted towards students in grades 4, 7, 10, 11, and 12, as well as their parents.

The survey's start date is January 13, 2025, and will be open until February 24, 2025. Students and parents should be given the same login link to access the survey for your school.
