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BIG IDEAS

Career-life development includes ongoing cycles of exploring, planning, reflecting, adapting, and deciding. Career-life decisions influence and are influenced by internal and external factors, including local and global trends. Engaging in networks and reciprocal relationships can guide and broaden career-life awareness and options.

A sense of purpose and career-life balance support well-being. Lifelong learning and active citizenship foster careerlife opportunities for people and communities.

Career-Life Connections is a required course for graduation. It is a 'real life' course, meaning that it is less academically focused and more practical. It will help you plan certain aspects of your life such as your future goals and dreams as well as giving you steps to take that will help you reach those goals and dreams. This course has a particular focus in building your own decision-making skills and your perspectives into career and post-secondary planning. You will develop a personalized Capstone Project that will culminate your course work and future life planning.
