Big Ideas

Listening and viewing with intent supports our acquisition of French.

The communicative context determines how we express ourselves.

Language and culture are interconnected and shape our perspective, identity, and voice. Exploring diverse forms of cultural expression promotes greater understanding of our own cultural identity. Acquiring French provides a unique opportunity to access and interact with the Francophone world. Developing proficiency in French provides diverse <u>opportunities</u>.

The study of French as a second language and culture is intended to enable learners to communicate effectively in French and provide them with opportunities to develop cultural awareness and appreciation.

This course is comprised of 5 core units that include cultural, grammatical and conversational activities among others. This course has been designed to meet the learning outcomes for French 11 as set by the British Columbia Ministry of Education. To achieve these outcomes, students will engage in structured language learning activities that build upon one another and upon previously learned concepts.
