## **Big Ideas**

Listening and viewing with intent supports our acquisition and understanding of French. We can have meaningful conversations in French about things that are important to us.

We can share our experiences and perspectives through stories.

Francophone <u>creative</u> <u>works</u> are expressions of Francophone cultures.

Acquiring French provides opportunities to explore our own cultural identity from a new perspective.

The study of French as a second language and culture is intended to enable learners to communicate effectively in French and provide them with opportunities to develop cultural awareness and appreciation.

This course is comprised of <u>5 core units</u> that include cultural, grammatical and conversational activities among others. This course has been designed to meet the learning outcomes for French 9 as set by the British Columbia Ministry of Education. To achieve these outcomes, students will engage in structured language learning activities that build upon one another and upon previously learned concepts.

## **ASSESSMENT**

Students will have the opportunity to demonstrate their learning through a variety of means such as: projects, quizzes, reflections, learning guides, and written assignments. Student growth and progress will be shared and communicated using the Provincial Proficiency Scale.
