- Minimum of 12 characters
- Must contain at least three of the following character types:
 - Uppercase letters
 - lowercase letters
 - Number 0 - 9
 - Symbols (#, *, !, ?, etc.)
- Not contain any part of your name

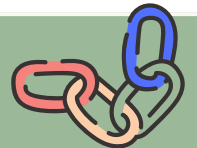
