Photography 10 is an introduction to this art and communication medium that will serve students well as a lifelong skill. This course will explore artistic expression and some introductory techniques for capturing moments in time. The word Photography means 'drawing with light'. You will explore capturing images that reflect artistic integrity and visual communication. Growing techniques for the camera and editing tools that you already have at your own disposal is the goal of this course.
